

## Competition Rules

The competition will be conducted in accordance with current ISU regulations and current DKB rules.

Participants must be members of an association or affiliated club which is a member of the ISU.

1. The aim of each team is to win the Heiko Fischer-Trophy. The four best results from each team will be used to determine team points.
2. Points will be awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> Place: 20 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: 18 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: 16 points, 4<sup>th</sup> Place 14 points, – for each place hereafter points awarded are reduced by one point per place. Team results will be added according to club or association.
3. Winner of the Trophy is the team with the most points. In case of a tie the team with the best result in the senior category is decisive.
4. The winning team receives € 400,00 and a replica of the Heiko Fischer Trophy, the second-placed team € 200,00 and the third-placed team € 100,00. All participants will receive diplomas.
5. The Heiko Fischer Trophy is a rotational challenge cup. It remains to the association or club which has won the challenge cup five times.
6. Prizes of honour will be awarded to the winners of each category.
